



BARL SAFETY INDUCTION - LEVEL 1 (SHORT FORM)

Introduction

Welcome to the Brisbane Airport Rail Link, known as the BARL. The purpose of this induction is to provide you with a brief overview of Transfield Services approach to Health, Safety and the Environment and the knowledge you need to ensure that your visit is as safe as possible. More detailed inductions are provided for persons who require longer term or specialised access.

Transfield Services is committed to providing its employees, Contractors and Visitors with a safe place of work, thus ensuring that you leave the BARL in the same state of physical and psychological well being that you arrived in.

Duty of Care Employer

Under the Queensland Work Health & Safety Act, Transfield Services has an obligation to ensure the health & safety of its employees. The Act also states that a person conducting a business undertaking has an obligation to ensure his or her own workplace health and safety and the health and safety of others is not affected by the way the employer conducts their undertakings.

Duties of Workers and Others

The Act states that a worker or anyone else at a workplace has the following obligations.

- (a) take reasonable care for his or her own health and safety; and
- (b) take reasonable care that his or her acts or omissions do not adversely affect the health and safety of other persons; and
- (c) comply, so far as the worker is reasonably able, with any reasonable instruction that is given by the person conducting the business or undertaking to allow the person to comply with this Act; and
- (d) Co-operate with any reasonable policy or procedure of the person conducting the business or undertaking relating to health or safety at the workplace that has been notified to workers.

Transfield Services is equally committed to the protection of the environment and insists that all activities and undertakings are not carried out without first assessing the impact these may have on our environment.

Transfield Services seeks the same commitment from Contractors and visitors to the BARL.

Access to the Brisbane Airport Rail Link

Prior to accessing the stations or platforms, all visitors must complete an entry in the visitor's logbook & collect a visitors pass. Held by the Administration Officer

Site Specific Personal Protective Equipment Requirements

You must wear relevant PPE appropriate to your activities. See your Transfield Services contact to ensure that you meet the BARL's minimum PPE requirements.

Track and Platform Access

Certain areas of the BARL structure are designated "Restricted Areas" and can only be accessed once the appropriate permits and authorities to work have been approved. You will be advised of any special access requirements, which may be relevant to your activities.

Hazard Identification and Incident Reporting

If, during your time at the BARL, you identify anything which you believe to be unsafe or harmful to persons or the environment, please report it to any Transfield Services personnel.

If you are involved in any incident or sustain any injury, you must report it to Transfield Services immediately. This will ensure that you receive the appropriate treatment and will allow Transfield Services the opportunity to investigate the incident so that the root causes can be identified and appropriate control measures be put in place so as to prevent a recurrence.

Emergency Response

In the unlikely event of an emergency you must follow directions given to you by the Transfield Services staff members. It is important for your safety and the safety of all other persons that you obey any instruction given to you during any emergency situation.

If you have any concerns or are unsure about any safety requirements during your time at the BARL, please ask one of the Transfield Services personnel for guidance.

General

All personnel are to ensure that they do not allow themselves or any equipment to come within 3 metres of the 25kv overhead traction system. Persons affected by drugs or alcohol will not be permitted to access the Brisbane Airport Rail Link. Smoking is not permitted on the BARL.

Transfield hopes that your visit is a safe and memorable one.
